Supplies used by your student:

- 1: Backpack
- 1: Two-Pocket Folder (Without clasps)
- Change of clothes for an emergency (Keep in child's backpack)
- **Your child's name MUST be on the above items.*

- 2: Dozen-# 2 yellow FAT pencils with erasers (sharpened, if possible)
- 2: Boxes of Crayola crayons 16 count
- 2: Pink pearl erasers
- 2: Baby wipes (1- 80 ct box) NOT CLOROX
- 1: Hand Sanitizer (antibacterial 8 oz)
- 1: Tissues (1 large box)
- 1: Box of Ziploc bags *Boys bring: gallon size* *Girls bring: sandwich size*
- 6: Glue sticks .28 oz.
