School Choice

Agora Cyber Charter School is a school of choice. We are a public school option to a student's local school district. As of July 21, 2011 Agora student enrollment is 5640.

The federal *No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB)* requires school districts in School Improvement I, School Improvement II, Corrective Action I or Corrective Action II to offer parents the option to send their child to another public school within the district.

As a cyber charter school, the school choice requirement is not applicable to Agora. If we did have to offer school choice, all of our 5640 students would be eligible.

Supplemental Educational Support (SES)

The federal *No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB)* requires public educational placements in School Improvement I, School Improvement II, Corrective Action I or Corrective Action II to offer eligible students the opportunity for supplemental education services from a state approved provider.

2008-2009 was Agora's first year to participate in SES. This program will be continued for the 2011-2012 School Year. To support the program and meet the NCLB mandate, 20% of Title I funds are set aside for SES. All eligible families are identified in the fall and sent notification of eligibility, an explanation of the program, and the names of state approved providers. Eligibility is based on a family meeting the federal low-income guidelines. Participation is prioritized on the basis of academic need as defined by Agora.

As of July 21, 2011 for the 2011-2012 school year, 3554 students are eligible for SES and will be sent notification of eligibility.
