Participating students should already have a paid version of Minecraft for PC or Mobile if they would like to join the server build days.* The task, should you choose to accept the challenge, is to build a dynamic and environmentally friendly city following the weekly objectives. Our final week of camp will end with a showcase of the amazing talents of our students.

Students who choose to join the K12 server for build days will need to have a Learning Coach authorization that will be explained in the Live Camp sessions. All sessions will be one hour.
