LEARNING COACH APPRECIATION GUIDELINES

Eligibility

- K12-powered students in kindergarten through 12th grade, or anyone else who wants to thank a Learning Coach, are eligible to participate.
- Students who are 13 years of age or younger will need their parent/guardian to post on their behalf.
- A panel will review all tributes, and all approved tributes will be featured in the K12 Online Gallery.

Prompt

Our second annual [Learning Coach Appreciation](#) extravaganza is our way of thanking our Learning Coaches for everything they do for their families.

To help us celebrate, all students in grades K–12 are encouraged to create a written work, a piece of artwork, a poem, a song, or any other imaginative means they'd like to thank their Learning Coach.

Not a student but still want to thank a Learning Coach? We welcome appreciation from anyone who wants to share!

Media and Technique Requirements

Any of the following media or techniques may be used:

- Artwork
- Video
- Written
- Act of Kindness

Size Requirements

- Photo files should be no larger than 50 MB.
- Photo files must be .jpg, or .png; no other file type will be accepted.
- Photo resolution should not exceed 3000 x 3000 pixels.
- Video files must be smaller than 2 GB.
- Video files must be .avi, .mpg, .mp4, .mov, or .wmv; no other file type will be accepted.
- Video submissions should not exceed two minutes in length.

Copyright Law

All tributes must be original and created entirely by the student. Any work that is copyrighted will be rejected. For example, no work taken directly from television shows, movies, video games, or books will be accepted; however, student-created replicas will be allowed.

Multiple Entries

Students may upload as many tributes as they'd like.

SUBMISSION OF TRIBUTES

1. Go to stories.k12.com/node/add/story
2. Enter the required information (e.g., name, age, etc.). Please note that if a student is under 13 years of age, a parent/guardian may post a tribute on the student's behalf by entering the student's name and the parent's/guardian's date of birth. The parent/guardian must note in the "[Tell Us About Your Learning Coach](#)" box that they are posting for the student. Create a separate story for each student entered and for each tribute posted.
3. Upload your tribute by selecting "[Photo](#)" in the dropdown menu under "[Upload Photo or Video](#)."
4. In the "[Tell Us About Your Learning Coach](#)" box, give a brief description (up to 800 words) of your Learning Coach and explain how your tribute shows your appreciation.

Deadline for Entries

All tributes must be received no later than 5 PM (ET) on [Friday, April 3, 2020](#), to be eligible.
