

Spanish 1 – Credit Recovery

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course provides students with instruction in the basics of learning the language of Spanish. This includes but is not limited to the vocabulary topics of greetings, time, dates, colors, clothing, numbers, weather, family, houses, sports, food and school. The course also introduces basic and stem-changing verbs and their formation and use in the present tense. Students also learn about interrogatives, question formation, and adjectives and their form and use, in addition to possessives, prepositions, and other grammatical structures. Finally, students will become acquainted with the Spanish-speaking countries of the world and their cultures.

- Recognize and use basic Spanish vocabulary.
- Communicate in simple narrative and interrogative situations.
- Recognize and use the present tense structure.
- Form and use adjectives for basic communication.
- Become familiar with the Spanish-speaking countries of the world and the basics of their cultures.
