English Language Arts – we are shooting for 65% - we are having professional development for staff to help with this

Dropout & Grad rates – not as good as we would like – trying to get to the 80.7% rate – talked about dropout tracking and finding out where students went

Attendance – we are holding student more accountable – want to make a connection as to why school matters – talked about students taking classes at Community College of Aurora

Graduation for students with disabilities – looking at grad plans for students

Targets – attendance 92.5% - graduation 50% - ELA growth 56%

Talked about goals we write will be for the next school year

PBiS – creating positive statements and a social contract that is explicitly and purposefully teach expectations – give praise for displays of appropriate behavior

Showed the Southridge Pride – Kenwood Pride

Talked about our social contract and to find ways to incorporate it into our positive word
