## Placement Guidance

### Requirements – 3 Credits (cannot be waived)

- Algebra 1 A/B (lowest level allowed)
- Geometry A/B
- Algebra 2 A/B or 3<sup>rd</sup> Year Math

Advanced students can use PreCalc or Calc to meet the 3-credit requirement if no Algebra 1/Geom credit.

### Replacing Alg2 with 3<sup>rd</sup> Year Math Notes

- Must be aligned with HSBP goals
- NOT for 4 year college enrollment

### Use CR First

If a student has attempted the course previously and they have a strong prior attempt (engaged in the course) use CR. See CR Section for more info.

NOTE: No concurrent enrollments with companion course. Example: Don't schedule MTH126A AlgA CR with 128B Alg B in the same term. Schedule AlgA CR first, then 128B in a later term.

### Frequently Asked Questions:

- What about transfer students?

After reviewing a student's prior credits, use the above placement guide and do a "best match" placement based on student needs. Attempt to follow our sequence whenever possible.

- What about special education students?

Students should follow the appropriate sequence based on their post high school plans. Teachers will provide required accommodations and modifications as outlined in their IEPs.

- Do students need to take Chemistry?

Students planning to attend a four-year university need to take Chem A & B for college admission. If a student is not planning to attend a four-year university, Physical Science B also introduces chemistry concepts and addresses those required state standards.

\*Anatomy and Physiology is considered a 2 for 1 credit. This means that students earn a 1.0 Science lab credit while meeting the CTE graduation requirement.
