

1st Grade **Daily** Checklist



Learning Coach Checklist

- Read emails
- Check Daily Plan for scheduled
 - ✓ Lessons—Focus on mastering each lesson's objectives. The objectives are found at the beginning of each lesson.
 - ✓ ClassConnect Sessions
- Log attendance and progress. (25 hours a week/5 hours a day)
 - ✓ Log in 1 hour of health attendance for every day of school.
 - ✓ Log supplemental time daily-reading, educational TV shows, educational websites, etc. (up to 12 hours a week)

Remember that at this age, most students can concentrate 10-20 minutes. Break up the lessons in mini-parts and give quick moving/stretching breaks in between.

Daily Language Arts Checklist

- Write at least one complete sentence building up to a 5 sentence paragraph with details by the end of the year.
- Language Arts lessons as scheduled on daily plan: Literature & Comprehension, Phonics Works, Handwriting, Vocabulary, Writing Skills
- Reading Eggs (1 lesson a day: My Lessons/Map, Driving Tests, Skills Bank)

- Sight word practice –
 - Flash cards provided with curriculum
 - <http://Noodleverse.k12.com> > Word and Word Parts (Kingdom of Figment)> Sight Words (Aether City)
- 40 minutes of reading. Choose the most appropriate activity/activities for your child:
 - Model reading - Read aloud to your student at least 20 minutes a day. (Use books your student cannot read on his/her own.)
 - Shared reading – You and your student read together as your student follows along while you read and then repeats familiar refrains. (Use books your student cannot read on his/her own.)
 - Student reads orally (i.e. Phonics Works Readers that is assigned for the Phonics lesson your child is currently on.)
 - Student reads silently once s/he has mastered fluent, expressive reading (pleasure-reading)

Daily Math Checklist

- One Math lesson
