

STAR360 assessments in Math and Reading provides information regarding your strengths, weaknesses and your growth in both subjects. You will take these tests several times during the year to track your progress.

Each assessment has 34 questions and will take about 20-30 minutes and you may pause and restart if you wish. You will not be allowed to return to previous questions and the questions will change each time you take the test. (Early Literacy test has 27 questions)

The first time you take each test, it will start with three practice questions. After answering at least two correctly, it will move on to the actual assessment questions. **Generally, you will have between 1 ½ - 3 minutes to answer each question. A small clock will appear at the top of the screen as a 30 second warning. You should just pick an answer within that time or else the assessment will move on to the next question.** While pencil and paper may be used, no calculators should be allowed. If a calculator is needed for higher level math questions, it will appear on the screen. Your teacher will provide you with a report of your test results.

You will experience some questions you don't know the answer or time will run may run out before you can get an answer – and that's ok! Just do your best!



To Stop (submit) or pause a test, select STOP TEST in upper-right corner of the screen. Stopping a test will log you out of the program and you will be asked to log back in to take another test. If you pause a test, you must go back and finish it within 7 days. **To RESUME a stopped test, you will need to enter the password: ORVA.**

Stopping a Test on a Computer

1. Select **Stop Test** in the upper-right corner of the screen **A**. 
2. Select one of the following options: 

Option	Choose When...	Notes
B Resume Later	You want to stop the test, but plan to come back to it later.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Test score will be recorded after test is resumed and completed. ▶ Test will resume on the same question number, but the problem presented will be different (see page 49). ▶ Resume Later can only be used during the actual test, not during the practice session. (Stop Test and Cancel are the only options available at that time.)
C Stop Test	You want to stop the test; you have finished with it and have no plans to come back to it.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Test score will not be recorded. ▶ The next time the student logs in to take a test, the student will begin a new test.
D Cancel	You want to continue taking the test now instead of pausing or stopping it.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ Test continues as usual.
