### **School Goals**

**Academic Proficiency**

**By EOY, 40% of students will show proficiency in ELA**

**By EOY, 50% of students will show proficiency in Math**

### **Academic Proficiency using STAR data**

ELA increased from 28% to 29% (Goal: 40%)  
Math increased from 31% to 37% (Goal: 50%)  
Slight increase in participation in BOY/MOY

### **PPOS Attendance by Instructional Levels**

54% of Below Basic students attending ELA SGs and LGs  
53% of Below Basic students attending Math SGs and LGs  
44% of Basic students attending ELA SGs and LGs  
53% of Basic students attending Math SGs and LGs

### **Root Cause and Action Plan for Academic Growth**

BOT plans are challenging to track  
There is an alternative way to track if students are watching recordings  
Truancy policy for small groups: In progress

#### **Q3 Action items:**

Continue to work with data to individualize instruction for whole group, small group, and one-on-one by utilizing accurate data for each student  
Strategies for increasing attendance at CC sessions  
Working on sending regular progress reports to LCs/parents

### **School Goal: Decrease drop-out Rate by 5%**

SY 2015-16: Drop out rate 16.7%  
SY 2016-17: Drop out rate 15.2%

GED Prep Program is approved for PPOS; under development now  
Continuing Education and Career & Tech Partnerships currently under development  
PPOS will offer concurrent enrollment as many as more than 10 Colorado Colleges

### **State Accountability Overview**

Last Year: In 2016 PPOS was in Turnaround status (19.7/100 points)  
This Year: 34.7/100 points. No longer turnaround school.  
NOW: Priority Improvement status
